

- Attributes in Relational Databases:
 - "An attribute is a distinct characteristic for which data is maintained."
 - That's the art of Data Modelling:
 - What are relevant distinct characteristics?





Perceptual Properties

- "...not so distinct characteristics for which data should be maintained because it is important to users"
 - Data model should represent how users perceive the entities!
 - Perception is **subjective!**
 - Perception is hard to model!
 - Perception of different people might be conflicting and contradictive!
 - If we can do it: Allows for human-centered queries
 - Queries and schema which adapts to people perception



Perceptual Properties

- Perception of different people might be conflicting and contradictive!
 - But: Limited number of consensual views


Perceptual Properties – Where to start?

- Where to obtain perception? Exploit Social Judgements!
 - User provided feedback for database items
 - Reviews, Ratings, Votes, Tags, etc.
 - Aspect-oriented Sentiment Analysis, text mining, crowdsourcing, etc.
- Easier start: Latent Perceptual Properties
 - We aim for high-dimensional latent properties
 - Useful for query-by-example, similarity navigation, clustering, recommendation, etc.

- Perceptual Properties
